As manufacturers develop new hardware and upgrade components, older parts are soon discontinued and support is pulled for older machines.

Also, machines become less safe to use as they age.

Why Are Older Machines Not As Safe?

One of the biggest threats facing your business is a cyberattack. And your outdated equipment could leave the door wide open for hackers to infiltrate your network.

You see, when operating system providers, such as Windows and Apple release new OS versions, cybercriminals begin to find vulnerabilities to exploit.

These vulnerabilities are then fixed with a 'patch' and an updated OS version is released.





However, developers create newer operating systems and software with their latest machines in mind.

This means that older machines are often incompatible with the latest updates, leaving them wide open to attacks.

For example, a 2009 iMac can only run macOS 'High Sierra'. However, Apple has released 5 major operating systems since.
